The company plans to continue this important partnership moving forward in 2017 by planting approximately 100,000 trees, some of which replace trees destroyed by windstorms and wildfires.

"Lands' End is a leading reforestation partner of the NFF," said Wes Swaffar, Director of Ecosystem Services. "We're grateful for Lands' End's sustainability leadership and look forward to continuing our work together of restoring our National Forests and Grasslands."

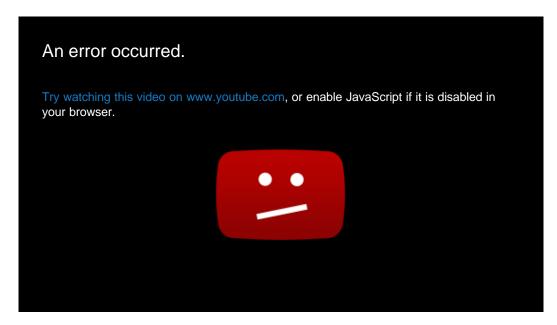
